I just read the minutes of the March 2008 Historial Society. Frances Ann "Puss" Denton was married to Nathan Pope the son of Calvin Pope. I have the dates, I can send you those later. My mother was the granddaughter of "Dide" Pope Kinslow the sister of Nathan. My mother spoke freguently of Aunt Puss. When my mother was only a year old her mother passed away and her grandmother "Dide Pope Kinslow reared her. She was very fond of Aunt "Puss". Aunt Puss never had any children. One story my mother told me was that before she died she had a stroke. She would cry and want her baby. They would put a doll in the bed with her and she would be happy. I always thought how sad.
