### **Treaty of the Holston celebration - James White's Fort**

The Treaty of the Holston will be celebrated at the James White Fort in Knoxville, Tennessee, Saturday, June 27, 2009, 10 am – 4 pm. The following events will be held.

- History of the Treaty of the Holston & the aftermath (Dr. Michael Toomey)
- Cherokee Life before and after the Europeans (Mark and Sherry Finchum)
- Cherokee Storytelling & dancing
- Treaty of the Holston signing ceremony

The above schedule is tentative and subject to change in advance as well as on the day of the event. In addition to the events listed above, guests will have the opportunity to tour the various buildings of the fort, observe blacksmithing and open hearth cooking demonstrations, as well as visit the Cherokee campsites outside the fort walls. There are also plans to have period music performed during lulls in the day's schedule.

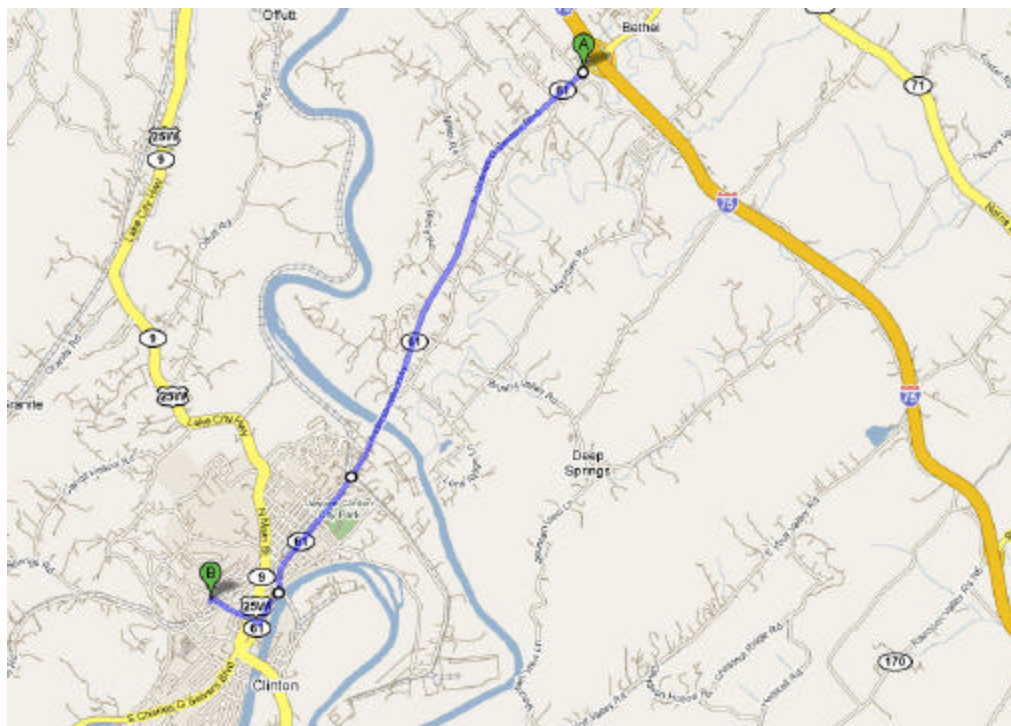
## **June Meeting:**

2. Turn right at E Broad St - 0.3 mi
3. Turn right at W Broad St - 0.2 mi
