Oueries:

Hudson (follow up from the May newsletter)

I wrote on Facebook that I was seeking info on James R. C. Hudson. Do think he is incorrectly identified in the 1850 census? He may be in the house of Thomas Hudson. I think he is identified as James R. C. M. on rootsweb and James R. Cull on ancestry. If this is him, was Thomas his father or grandfather? Thomas was from North Carolina, and appears in early land records for Anderson county. Hope someone there might know the family. James went to Missouri about 1857-8 with his wife and two children. He joined the Union Army in 1862, and died in 1863 outside Vicksburg. Sadly Rachil died about 1867, in Licking, Mo. She had married(?) Eckle McKinney prior to that. He was from East TN, also. The 1870 census has three boys in McKinney's home with the last name of Hudson. Personally, I believe two are James, and Radius, is McKinneys. The one identified as J, is Joseph Parker Hudson actually born in Clinton. He married shortly after that, and by 1880 the other two boys are identified as McKinney. James is my 3 g's grandfather. His oldest son Joseph Parker Hudson was born in Anderson Co. approx 1853. Family lore had them at Halls Crossroads prior to Missouri. Any help will be appreciated. Thank you, Janette Hudson.

Hicks

Hi, I was wondering if you could possibly help me identify the husband of Parasidia Burton Hicks who is interred at Sunset Cemetery in Anderson Co. TN. This is the information that I have on her:

Parsidia Burton Hicks, Born 1-24-1849 in Anderson Co. TN, died, 10-30-1913 in Anderson Co. TN

I have the death certificates of her two sons:

John Wesley Hicks born-3-18-1872 Anderson Co. TN, died 11-19-1933 Anderson Co. TN
Buried at Pleasant View Cemetery in Anderson Co. Death certificate lists Father as "Don't Know"
William H. Hicks born B-5-18-1881 in Anderson Co. TN, died 3-9-1920 in Anderson Co. TN
Buried at "Clinton" Death certificate lists Father as Sam Hicks

I can't find any other information on a Sam Hicks. This is the only place I have seen him show up in relation to Parasidia Hicks. Parasidia's maiden name was Burton so I am assuming she either married the father and/or just took his name. Any help you all can render would be appreciated.
