Wallace

I am trying to obtain information on Martha Elizabeth (Lizzie) Wallace during the period between 1890 and 1930. Her father was Calvin Riley Wallace (son of James Miller Wallace) and her mother was Serelda Jane Lamar. She married William (Billy) DF Brooks on 3 December 1885 in Anderson County TN. She appears in the 1870, 1880, 1930, and 1940 US Census in Anderson County TN. She was married several times and her last marriage was to an unknown Loy. Lizzie died on 5 January 1948 and is buried in Bethel Cemetery (Baptist). Her headstone reads Lizzie Loy, May 5 1869-January 5 1948. Any information on Lizzie Wallace would greatly appreciated.
